Icebreaker - Have you had any life altering conversations in your life?

Read the account of the woman at the well John 4:1-26

- John says that Jesus had to go through Samaria, although geographically speaking this was not the case. What do you think compelled him to enter the region? (Remember Jews and Samaritans had an intense hatred towards each other).
- How do you think the disciples would have felt about this?
- Is there anywhere you feel compelled to go and share the Gospel that would be frowned upon by others?
- How do we know this woman had a bad reputation?
- If you knew the woman's background what would you have thought of her / how would you have approached her?
- How did Jesus show Grace to this woman?
- What does Jesus mean by 'living water'?
- How had this woman tried to make herself happy up until now? What was the result?
- Are there things in your life that you felt would satisfy you, only to end up disappointed?
- How would you feel if you met someone who knew every detail about your life?
- Why did Jesus need this woman to look at the sin in her life? Why do we?
- What does the woman's question in verse 20 reveal about her?
- What does Jesus answer reveal about him?
- Why do you think she left her jar behind when she went into the village to tell others about Jesus? (John 4:28)
