## **Life Group Notes**

## God is...GREAT

**Read**: Isaiah 40:12-31; Dan. 11:32 KJV; Heb. 12:1-2; Psalm 121:1-4; 139:1-6; 145:1-3; Romans 11:33KJV;

- 1. Read Isaiah 40:12-31. What does this chapter tell us about God?
- 2. Would you agree that a deficient view of God produces a deficient faith? Why?
- 3. Martin Luther once told Erasmus, the humanist leader of the Renaissance, "Your thoughts of God are too human!" Do you think he might have said the same to us? (Is your God one for whom nothing is impossible?)
- 4. Steve used three words in an attempt to describe God [incomprehensible, incorruptible; incomparable]. Did any of these words surprise you? What words would you use to describe God?
- 5. In which way is God incomprehensible? (see Psalm 139:1-6; Psalm 145:1-3).
- 6. Counting at the speed of 3 every second it would take us 3 trillion years to count every star in the universe! Why should that detail be important to us as Christians? In which way does a study on God's greatness encourage and inspire you to persevere through hard circumstances?
- 7. Is simply believing in the greatness of God enough to get us through life's trials?
