

## **Lifegroup Questions - Discipleship**

- What comes to mind when you think about the word discipleship?
- Read Matthew 28:16-20 how do you feel about Jesus command in this passage? How good are you at following this command?
- Read Luke 9:23-24 What is the expectation that Jesus places on his disciples in these verses? What does this look like for you?
- What other expectations does Jesus place on his disciples? (Some helpful verse might be John 8:31, John 13:35, John 15:8) How easy is it to be a disciple of Jesus?
- As you read through the gospels what do you notice about Jesus model of discipleship? How is it different from other models you have been taught/experienced?
- Nearly all of Jesus discipleship took place outside of formal gatherings. Where do you feel as though you have been discipled by Jesus the most?
- Jesus said "Surely I am with you always" When you face challenging situations in your life do you consider turning to Jesus? Why/why not?
- Read Mark 1:16-18 What promise did Jesus make to Simon and Andrew? How
  was this fulfilled? Do you consider making disciples to be an essential part of
  your Christian journey? Why/why not?
- On Sunday Dan said that discipleship, begins with commitment, grows through intimacy, results in change and achieves a purpose. Which of these areas do you find the most challenging?
- How might you make discipleship a more regular part of your walk with Jesus? (this question refers to both your own discipleship and your discipleship of others)
